Yare Valley Churches PCC Meeting held at The Rectory 10.6.25 at 7.30 p.m.

These are the key points/decisions from the last meeting:

- Judy Gerrard was co-opted as PCC Secretary and began her role at the PCC meeting on 10th June 2025.
- The YVC Annual Accounts were approved at an extraordinary meeting on 13th April 2025.
- The following PCC Officers were approved: Lay Chair of PCC Patrick Beales, PCC Treasurer Mrs Gillian Groat, PCC Secretary Mrs Judy Gerrard, Electoral Roll Officer Mr Ian Dougall. Independent Examiner not yet appointed.
- It was agreed that the Standing Committee/Leadership Team would be made up of the following members of the PCC: Revd. Dave Hanson, Mr Keith Gerrard, Mrs Gillian Groat, Mr Tom Morgan, Ms Libby Morgan.
- It was agreed that we join the HydroCare for Work Service Plan for the hot water boiler in the SLC.
- It was agreed that the Rainbow Room be removed from the churchyard by DR Cole Demolitions.
- A replacement television has been purchased to replace the faulty one at Brundall Church.
- A new structure for the sub committees has been accepted by the PCC. OF subcommittee to be replaced by POLICY & PARTNERSHIP subgroup, and IN and FINANCE subcommittees to be replaced by FABRIC & FINANCE subgroup. Plus, the introduction of the following subgroups which would replace OUT & UP: WORSHIP/DISCIPLESHIP, CHILDREN/YOUTH/FAMILIES, PASTORAL, COMMUNITY.
- At the Community Pantry, it has been agreed that the sessions on Monday and Thursday will run until 12.30. There will also be a trial provision of hot drinks, and biscuits, for 3 months on a Thursday.
- The revised Yare Valley Churches General Privacy Notice, updated on 28th May will be published on our website.
- A Yare Valley Churches Safeguarding Action Plan and an updated Recruitment of Ex- offenders Policy has been approved.
- The PCC has approved a request to reserve a single and a double grave space at Braydeston Church.
